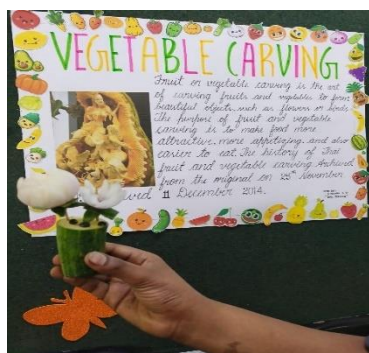
This celebration was a reminder of the critical role doctors play in our lives and an opportunity to express appreciation for their unwavering dedication to society.
