Recitation Competition for Primary Students


"Voices of Expression, Rhymes of Joy – Primary Students Shine in the Recitation Competition!"

Field Trip to Salar Jung Museum


"Exploring Heritage, Embracing History – Grades 3 and 4 Discover the Wonders of Salar Jung Museum!"

Field Trip to Golconda Fort by High School Students


"Stepping Back in Time – High School Students Explore the Majestic Golconda Fort!"


The joy on everyone's faces as they turned simple veggies into masterpieces was truly heartwarming. This activity reminded us how small things can create big impressions, both in art and life.
