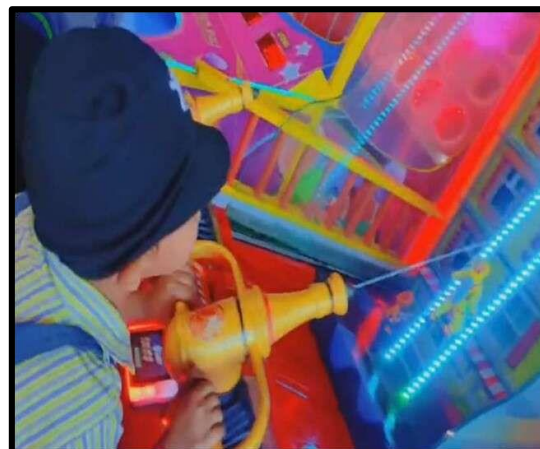
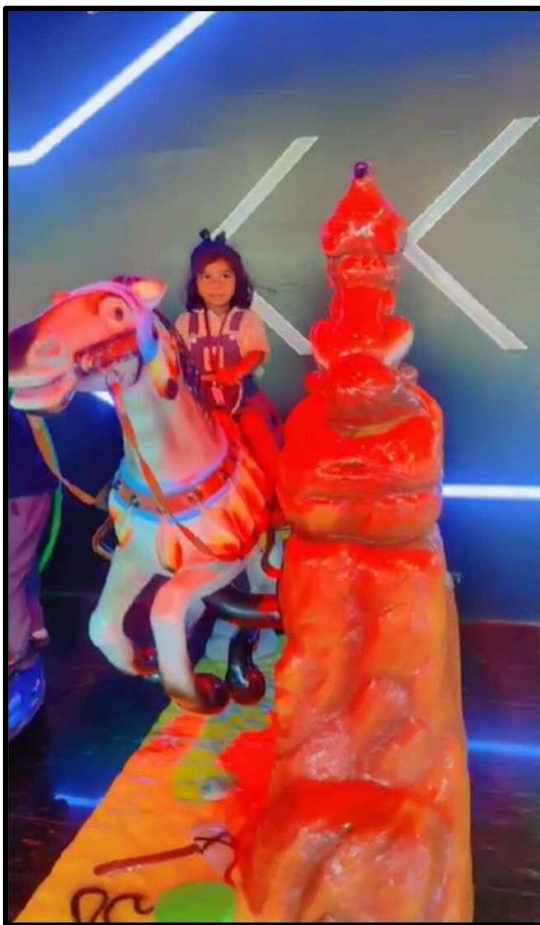


“A Day of Thrills and Smiles at Thrill City!”
