Healthy eating starts young, and today was a step towards making it fun!



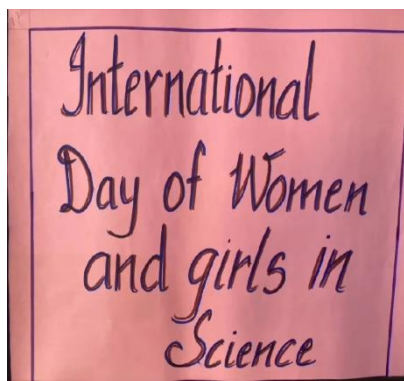

Students enjoyed exploring, bonding with friends, and making memories that will last a lifetime. The energy, excitement, and joy on their faces said it all!



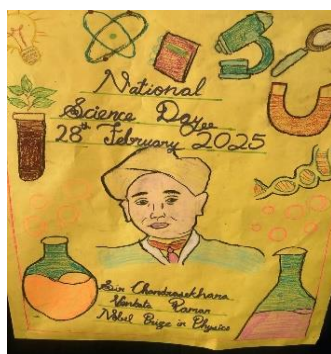
