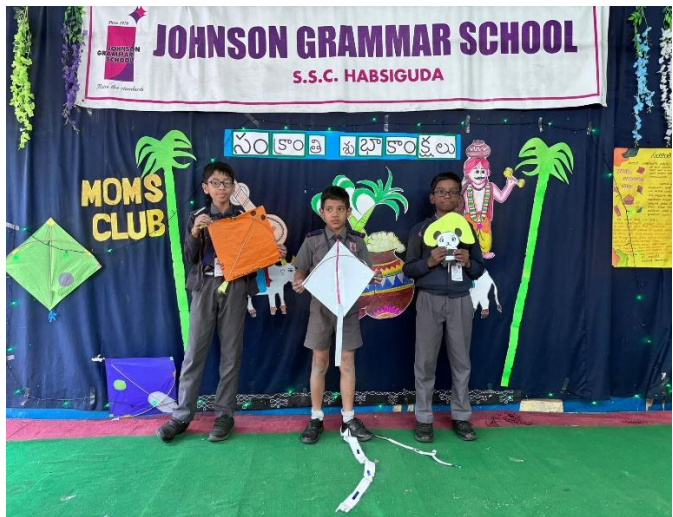
KITE MAKING ACTIVITY
